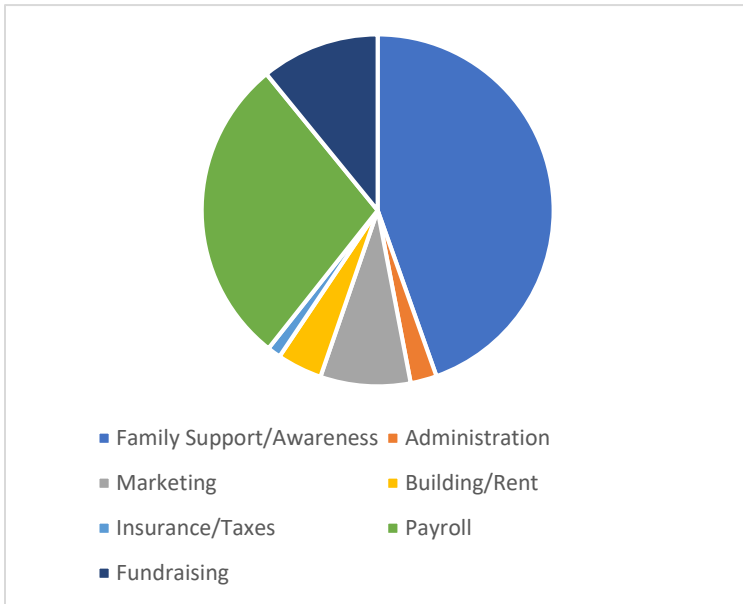

CAPITAL CAMPAIGN

In 2019, we launched the quiet phase of our capital campaign with the goal of raising \$1,000,000. These funds will be used to create the only dedicated community space in the United States to provide social, emotional and spiritual support for children and families impacted by skin conditions and birthmarks. This unique facility will be a place of acceptance and a place to belong for those we serve.

To help these children truly see themselves as the masterpieces they were made to be, we have many incredible plans and BIG dreams for all we can offer in our new house: a salon where children with hair loss can try on wigs and play with hairstyles if they like; a makeup studio where children with pigment loss and birthmarks can safely experiment with camouflaging makeups if they wish; a place where young adults with skin conditions can gather around the table over a meal to mentor younger children with the same condition; spaces for art, music, and therapeutic play; areas for support sessions for moms, dads and siblings; play areas for babies and toddlers so families can meet in a safe space to talk and share experiences; sitting areas for meditation and journaling; a library full of wonderful resources; a game center and movie theater for fun events that build community and let these children know they are not alone.
